New Distinguished Faculty

Sifu (Teacher), author and filmmaker, Terence Pang-Yen Dunn is creator of the Tai Chi For Health video series used by millions since 1989. He has 40 years of experience in the Tai Chi Chuan, ChiGong , and four styles of Chinese Boxing (kung-fu). Educated at Yale College and the Harvard Business School, Dunn blends knowledge of East and West to make ancient health treasures accessible today. Sifu Dunn has pioneered Chi Gong and Tai Chi practice in medicine and professional sports, establishing the first Tai Chi and Qigong therapy protocols for inpatients at major hospitals such as Cedars Sinai Medical Center to accelerate patient recovery from surgeries, and becoming the first Tai Chi trainer in the NBA. Dunn trains elite professional athletes, including the Los Angeles Lakers.
