Down below, there is a table with the stated limits that, in April of 2012, were sent out for the first time to students; it was announced at that time that they were to be implemented in the Emperor's clinic starting in January, 2013. This table lists how many shifts an intern is allowed to take each quarter, depending on what level of internship the intern has reached. It shows that students are not permitted to complete the internship process in less than 7 quarters. Please be mindful that "permitted" does NOT mean guaranteed. Just because you are permitted to take a certain number of shifts during a particular level of internship does not mean you are guaranteed to get that number of shifts. However, keep in mind that during my 8 years as Clinic Director, there has not been even one case of any full-time student who been unable to complete the program within the 4-year period due to any of the processes that are and that have been in place regarding the lottery and registration.

There is also, just below, 2 links to the Emperor's College website--specifically, one is to the page where the Recommended Course Sequence (RCS) document is and the other to the page where the Pre-Requisites document is. ***ISTRONGLY*** urge you to carefully review these documents at the very beginning of your process here at Emperor's College and ***regularly*** after that as you continue along in the program.

From the start, you should be aware of the fact that the RCS shows that this is a 4-year (full time) program and that this includes completing the internship process in 8 quarters (therefore taking even one quarter longer than the allowable minimum speed stated in the table below

EVERYONE ON FINANCIAL AID IN THIS PROGRAM SHOULD PAY VERY CLOSE ATTENTION TO THESE NEXT TWO PARAGRAPHS!

The current required minimum number of units students need to take each quarter to maintain financial aid status is 9 units (be aware that one 50-hour clinic shift—observation or internship—equals 2.5 units). For your classes that you take prior to going into the clinic (i.e., prior to becoming an observer), to be on a 4-year pace and adhere to the required pre-requisite sequence, you would need to average about 14 units per quarter, and on any one quarter that would involve typically taking anywhere from 13 to about 16 units.

If you go faster than this (i.e., take more units than this per quarter in your first two years), when you reach the point where you are an intern, you will most likely have finished so many classes that you will eventually run out of classes to take before you complete your internship and, in order to maintain financial aid status, be needing to take more clinic shifts than is allowed for one or more levels of your internship process. Do NOT go that fast and then later on expect the administration to allow you to go faster in clinic than the stated limits in order to maintain financial aid. If YOU make the choice to go faster than what is laid out in the recommended course sequence (see below), the consequences of your actions, your choices, when you get into clinic, are yours and only yours to live with. To be forewarned is to be forearmed.

Clinical Training Timeframe

Clinical internship is the important stage of applying theoretical information learned in the classroom setting and integrating it into the student experience. Similarly to cramming for a test, if this process is done too quickly, full comprehension of diagnostic and treatment principles is not gained. For these reasons a standard timeframe for completing the clinical training component of the master's program is outlined below.

Level Intern	Max Clinical Courses Allowed
1 st Quarter Intern	1 Course / Qtr
Level 1	2 Courses / Qtr
Level 2	2 Courses / Qtr
Level 3	3 Courses / Qtr
Level 4	4 Courses / Qtr

Total: 800 hours / Completed in no less than 7 quarters

Note: A 50 hour clinical course is 2.5 academic units

A maximum of four (4) banked shifts can be completed per quarter. There is no quarterly limit for banked hours which are completed in the 13th week of each quarter and/or at college-sponsored community outreach events.
